## CHICORA REGION AACCA CLUB

The Chicora Region antique Automobile club is the oldest antique car club in this area. It is a direct affiliate of the Antique Automobile Club of America (AACCA), which is the oldest and largest of its kind in the world.

The Chicora club is family oriented and is open to the public. Ownership of an antique car is not required for membership. To become a member of the Chicora Club, you must first become a member of the AACCA. Dues for AACCA are \$40.00 per year and dues for the Chicora Club are \$15.00 per year. Meetings are held monthly, usually in the afternoon of the third Sunday. The club has a web site on the Internet ([www.chicoracarclub.com](http://www.chicoracarclub.com)) and publishes an award winning monthly newsletter.

Since its beginnings in the 1970's, the Chicora club has supported local charities such as: Waccamaw Youth Center, Horry County Shelter Home, Salvation Army, victims of natural disasters, churches assisting individuals and/or families, and many other causes. We help sponsor and judge the Cruise to the Coast show at Barefoot Landing during the North Myrtle Beach Harvest Festival every fall.
